- Forty-three states have organized Kids' Chance programs that are actively providing need-based scholarships to the families of seriously injured workers, and new Kids' Chance organizations are being formed each year.
- Kids' Chance organizations have collectively awarded over 5,400 educational scholarships since their inception and distributed over
